

Advisory to the Public on Money Claims

The Commission on Audit (COA) received e-mails and calls from individuals based in Australia that certain people posing as employees of the Commission sent e-mails notifying them that they were beneficiaries of money claims and asking said Australians to fill-up a claimant allotment record form that included personal information.

Please be advised that COA does not initiate payments on money claims but acts on money claims against government only after a petition is filed by claimant.

Please do not give personal information such as your identification numbers, addresses and bank account numbers should you receive communications (written/e-mail/calls) from individuals posing as employees of COA saying that you are a beneficiary of a money claim and asking for such personal information.
